WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this outstanding institute be appropriately honored.

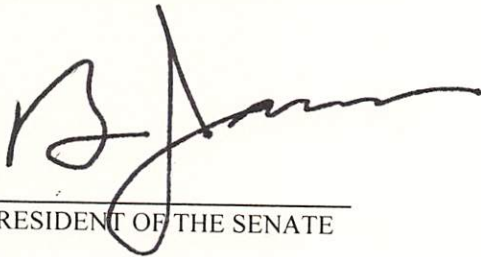

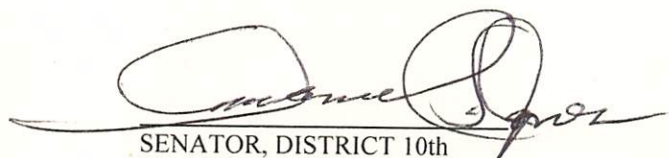
